

INITIAL RESOLUTION
(Clark Specialty Co. Inc. Project)

A regular meeting of the Steuben County Industrial Development Agency was convened on Thursday, January 28, 2021.

The following resolution was duly offered and seconded, to wit:

RESOLUTION OF THE STEUBEN COUNTY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY (THE "AGENCY") (i) ACCEPTING THE APPLICATION OF CLARK SPECIALTY CO. INC. WITH RESPECT TO A CERTAIN PROJECT (AS MORE FULLY DESCRIBED BELOW), (ii) AUTHORIZING A PUBLIC HEARING WITH RESPECT TO THE PROJECT, (iii) DESCRIBING THE FORMS OF FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE BEING CONTEMPLATED WITH RESPECT TO THE PROJECT, AND (iv) AUTHORIZING THE NEGOTIATION OF CERTAIN AGREEMENTS RELATING TO THE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, by Title 1 of Article 18-A of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York, as amended, and Chapter 178 of the Laws of 1972 of the State of New York, as amended (hereinafter collectively called the "Act"), the **STEUBEN COUNTY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY** (hereinafter called "Agency") was created with the authority and power to own, lease and sell property for the purpose of, among other things, acquiring, constructing and equipping industrial, manufacturing and commercial facilities as authorized by the Act; and

WHEREAS, in connection with the Project (defined herein) it is contemplated that the Agency will convey, pursuant to a quitclaim deed, to the Company (defined herein) in fee simple certain property located at 36 Delaware Avenue, Bath, New York 14810 for approximately twelve thousand dollars (\$12,000.00) (the "Purchase Price"); and

WHEREAS, it is contemplated the Purchase Price will be reduced by an amount credited to the Company (defined herein) for certain rental payments previously made; and

WHEREAS, **CLARK SPECIALTY CO. INC.**, for itself or on behalf of an entity to be formed by it or on its behalf (collectively, the "Company"), has submitted an application (the "Application"), a copy of which is on file with the Agency, requesting the Agency's assistance with respect to a certain project (the "Project"), consisting of: (i) the acquisition by the Agency of a leasehold or other interest in certain real property located at 36 Delaware Avenue, Bath, New York 14810 (the "Land", being more particularly described as tax parcel No. 159.17-01-006.100) and the existing improvements located thereon, consisting principally of an existing manufacturing building (the "Existing Improvements"; (ii) the planning, re-design, re-construction and operation of the Existing Improvements to accommodate certain items of

machinery and equipment, including, but not limited to a new lazer cutting machine, a ten (10) ton crate and a new powder coating line (collectively, the "Improvements"); and (iii) the acquisition of and installation in and around the Land, the Existing Improvements and Improvements by the Company of machinery, equipment, fixtures and other items of tangible personal property (the "Equipment"; and, together with the Land and the Improvements, the "Facility"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 18-A of the General Municipal Law the Agency desires to adopt a resolution describing the Project and the Financial Assistance (as defined below) that the Agency is contemplating with respect to the Project; and

WHEREAS, it is contemplated that the Agency will hold a public hearing and (i) negotiate and enter into a lease agreement (the "Lease Agreement"), a leaseback agreement (the "Leaseback Agreement"), and a payment-in-lieu-of-tax agreement (the "Tax Agreement"), (ii) take a leasehold interest (or other interest) in the Land, the Existing Improvements and the Improvements and personal property constituting the Facility (once the Lease Agreement, the Leaseback Agreement and the Tax Agreement have been negotiated), and (iii) provide Financial Assistance to the Company in the form of a partial real property tax abatement structured within the Tax Agreement (the "Financial Assistance").

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE STEUBEN COUNTY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Company has presented an Application in a form acceptable to the Agency. Based upon the representations made by the Company to the Agency in the Company's Application, the Agency hereby finds and determines that:

(A) By virtue of the Act, the Agency has been vested with all powers necessary and convenient to carry out and effectuate the purposes and provisions of the Act and to exercise all powers granted to it under the Act; and

(B) The Agency has the authority to take the actions contemplated herein under the Act; and

(C) The action to be taken by the Agency will induce the Company to develop the Project, thereby increasing employment opportunities in Steuben County, New York, and otherwise furthering the purposes of the Agency as set forth in the Act; and

(D) The Project will not result in the removal of a civic, commercial, industrial, or manufacturing plant of the Company or any other proposed occupant of the Project from one area of the State of New York (the "State") to another area of the State or result in the abandonment of one or more plants or facilities of the Company or any other proposed occupant of the Project located within the State; and the Agency hereby finds that, based on the Company's application, to the extent occupants are relocating from one plant or facility to another, the Project is reasonably necessary to discourage the Project occupants from removing

such other plant or facility to a location outside the State and/or is reasonably necessary to preserve the competitive position of the Project occupants in their respective industries; and

Section 2. The Agency hereby authorizes conveyance of the Land (or certain portions thereof) in fee simple to the Company pursuant to a certain quitclaim deed for \$12,000 (or such other amount as may be reduced pursuant to the credit to the Company of certain rental payments previously made). In addition, the Agency hereby authorizes conveyance of a portion of the Land to The Bath Volunteer Fire Department Inc. by quitclaim deed. All such conveyances shall result in the Agency no longer having a fee simple interest in any portion of the Land.

Section 3. The Chairman, Vice Chairman and/or Executive Director of the Agency are hereby authorized, on behalf of the Agency, to (A) hold a public hearing in compliance with the Act, and (B) negotiate (1) the Lease Agreement, pursuant to which the Company leases the Project to the Agency, (2) the related Leaseback Agreement, pursuant to which the Agency leases its interest in the Project back to the Company, (3) the Tax Agreement, pursuant to which the Company agrees to make certain payments in lieu of real property taxes for the benefit of affected tax jurisdictions, and (4) related documents; provided (i) the rental payments under the Leaseback Agreement include payments of all costs incurred by the Agency arising out of or related to the Project and indemnification of the Agency by the Company for actions taken by the Company and/or claims arising out of or related to the Project; and (ii) the terms of the Tax Agreement are consistent with the Agency's Uniform Tax Exemption Policy or the procedures for deviation therefrom have been complied with.

Section 4. The Agency is hereby authorized to conduct a public hearing in compliance with the Act.

Section 5. The officers, employees and agents of the Agency are hereby authorized and directed for and in the name and on behalf of the Agency to do all acts and things required and to execute and deliver all such certificates, instruments and documents, to pay all such fees, charges and expenses and to do all such further acts and things as may be necessary or, in the opinion of the officer, employee or agent acting, desirable and proper to effect the purposes of the foregoing resolutions and to cause compliance by the Agency with all of the terms, covenants and provisions of the documents executed for and on behalf of the Agency.

Section 6. These Resolutions shall take effect immediately.

The question of the adoption of the foregoing Resolution was duly put to vote on roll call, which resulted as follows:
