This is to certify that the Steuben County Industrial Development Agency has been established by special act of the New York State Legislature, and the following is set forth pursuant to

Section 856 of the New York State Industrial Development Act:

- (1) The special act, legislative bill entitled Introductory Bill 8435 was passed by the New York State Assembly on the 14th day of March, 1972 and was passed by the Senate on the 11th day of April, 1972.
- (2) The special act was signed into Law by Governor Nelson A. Rockefeller on the 25th day of April, 1972 and became Chapter 178 of the Laws of 1972 of the State of New York, and thereby the Steuben County Industrial Development Agency was duly created under said Chapter 178 of the Laws of 1972 which became effective April 25, 1972.
- (3) The name of the Agency is:
THE STEUBEN COUNTY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY.

- (4) The names of the members of the Agency, their Chairman, and their terms of office are as follows:

- (5) The facts establishing the need for such Agency in the municipality are as follows:

Steuben County has a population of nearly one hundred thousand people, is one of the largest counties in area in New York State and has two cities located therein. Industrial development has not been expanding within the county as has taken place in other up-state counties, although the many natural resources and potentials of the county are available. Existing industries in the county are interested in the funding of anti-pollution controls which have been mandated and further look to the expansion of their present facilities.

The purposes of the Steuben County Industrial Development Agency shall be to promote, develop, encourage and assist in the acquiring, construction, reconstruction, improving, maintaining, equipping and furnishing industrial, manufacturing, warehousing, commercial, pollution control and research facilities and thereby (advance the
