HEARING MODERATOR: Good evening everybody. 6:30, so we're going to go ahead and call the public hearing to order. I just want to read through some ground rules, introduce myself, and then we'll open it up for public comment. So for those of you who don't know me, I'm Jamie Johnson. I'm Executive Director of the Industrial Development Agency, and I want to thank all of you for attending tonight. Just so you know, the purpose of this Public Hearing is to gather written or oral comments on the proposed assistance being provided by the Steuben County Industrial Development Agency to help facilitate the development of Plattsburg Wind project and the Towns of Plattsburg, Wheeler, Avoca and Howard. Sheehan here is representing the project. Just so everyone is aware, the assistance being contemplated will be in the form of sales and use, tax exemptions and mortgage recording tax exemptions, along with a payment in lieu of tax schedule in accordance with the agency's policies. Anyone wishing to comment shall complete a privilege of the floor form and turn it into Jill Staats. Jill has them, if you haven't already filled them out. That will include your name and address for the record. We also ask that you limit your comments to three minutes. Transferring time to another person will not be permitted,

and when an individual's time is up, they will be asked to yield the floor. All persons providing comments shall not use lewd, obscene, profane, slanderous or libelous language, or speak or act in a manner that would tend to incite a breach of the peace. If an individual causes disruption, they will be asked to leave the hearing. written materials which an individual would like to make part of the official record and be submitted to myself or to Jill. Just a reminder, IDA representatives are here to listen to the public's comments and not express our opinions or views. IDA representatives will also not participate in a debate of the issue. A complete transcript of the hearing will be presented to the IDA board and posted on our website at www.SteubenCountyida.com. Steve Maier is here. with Harris Beach, our legal counsel representing the project. And at this time, I'm going to turn it over to him to run the public hearing.

MR. MAIER: Okay. Welcome, everyone. So, I guess we'll get right to it and we'll start calling names to speak. What I will do is, again, as Jamie said, we're limiting these to three minutes to speak. So, what I'll do is around, you know, when there's about 30s left, I'll just kind of give you a nonverbal cue to let you know that you're nearing the three minutes. So, first we have Ruth

MR. MAIER: It's right there. It's fine.

Yeah. So it's my understanding that a MS. MATILSKY: final turbine has been selected for the project. And the turbine model recorded by NYSO is the best of the 117-42 megawatt. I think that's correct. This is a turbine that is designed for highly severe kinetic conditions. when Terra-Gen enlisted the turbines it was going to use, this one was not mentioned. It's my understanding that this turbine is not type certified and has a provisional certificate. And I believe this means it is still undergoing field testing. On the draft permit at Terra-Gen submitted, it says on Page 77, "that there must be a design verification confirming that the wind turbines were designed in accordance with International Electro-technical Commission 61400 from 2019". And, I believe that means it's type certified, but the selected turbine is only provisionally certified and only meets the standards from 2005. What this provisionally certified It means that manufacturers can begin series means? production, manufacturing, even before full classification is achieved. This is particularly relevant in the context of wind energy, where it allows manufacturers to begin producing turbines while waiting the completion of field tests on the prototype. And it's my understanding of that

when they did their field tests on the turbines they said they were going to use, the specs were definitely different and this is a serious modification and should call for more testing. You can't just substitute one turbine for all the others and say, okay, it's okay. You need to know about the setbacks and the noise. studies that applied to the existing permit no longer apply to the standards of the permit. It's a major modification. And I assume that the Skida, represents the people of Steuben County. And, so I assume that your job is to protect us when you're trying to get in business, and I, I read your mission statement, and it was in there. I am somebody who believes that climate change is real. look, I worry about pollution, and I also worry that you do a project like this, the administration in Washington is not really gung ho on the wind turbines. And we get them -- we do this not in the right way. They are going to grasp any opportunity that they can to say, look it doesn't work. Thank you.
